FAMILY MEMBER (ARTICLE 10) VS JUNIOR MEMBER (ARTICLE 11)

I would like to put the following proposal for discussion and voting at the AGM on 20th March 2011:

PROPOSAL

Background:

Refer to Club Constitution Article 10 and 11.

Currently a spouse or spouses who are club approved golf playing members pay a monthly subscription fee of RM60 (wef 1 March 2011). They enjoy the same rights as a Junior Member (Article 11), however a Junior Member is paying the subscription fee of a full member.

A Junior Member also has to convert his/her status to full member upon attaining the age of 21 years if he/she so wishes to continue golfing in KGM. However a spouse or spouses continue to enjoy the golfing facilities and rights at all ages. In this respect they have more rights than a Junior Member and yet they are paying a nominally small fee of RM60/ month.

Proposed Change:

In consideration of the rights accorded to approved golf playing spouse or spouses being the same as a Junior Member, it is proposed that golf playing spouse or spouses pay the same subscription fee as that of a Junior Member under Article 11 of the constitution with immediate effect. Their benefits regarding to golf and conversion to full member will be the same as the Junior Member.
