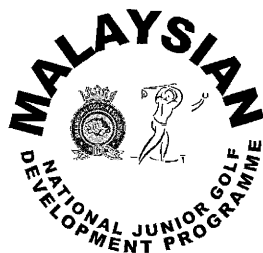

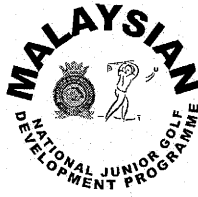

2012 MGA STATE JUNIOR CLINICS

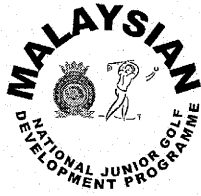
(A) OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the MGA State Junior Clinics are: -

- (i) To create an avenue for junior golfers to meet and develop friendship and camaraderie and to enhance good sportsmanship.
- (i) To acquire proper techniques of the golfing skills, mental preparation, course management, knowledge of the rules of golf rules and proper etiquette.
- (ii) To instil an awareness of the importance of good golf skills as an enhancement towards career opportunities in the golf industry.
- (iii) To select potential juniors from the clinics to participate in the Intermediate clinic
- (iv) Selected junior golfers without USGA Handicap Index will be registered in the NHS and given a handicap index.
- (v) To spot junior golfers with potential to be absorbed into National Junior Squad and subsequently the National Team.
- (vi) To facilitate in the registration of potential juniors in the National Junior rankings based on selected tournaments.

(B) PROGRAMME / EXPENSES / FACILITIES

1. All MGA State Junior Clinics will be held twice (2) a year in each state.
2. The MGA State Representatives are given the mandate to liaise and manage the junior clinics with MGA Affiliates in respective States concerned, at two selected venues in liaisons with the MGA Junior Development Programme Sub-Committee.
3. MGA will send a maximum of three (3) coaches to conduct the clinics whose expenses will be borne by MGA
4. MGA / Host Club will bear the cost of F&B expenses for all participants and coaches.



5. **All expenses related to the clinics shall be borne by MGA / State Association / Host Club except for the participants' travel which is to be borne by the participating clubs. The club to provide and take care the following expenses if any :-**
 - i. **Chipping Area**
 - ii. **Putting Area**
 - iii. **Bunker Area**
 - iv. **Driving Range**
 - v. **Golf Course for 9 holes for Intermediate players who should walk and carry their own golf bag**
6. The Clinics are open to Malaysian Citizen, aged 5 to 16 years for both male & female.
7. All entries must be submitted to the MGA State Representative or the State Golf Association whichever is applicable. The State Junior Committee headed by the MGA State Representative or the State Golf Association will decide on the selection of the 60 junior golfers for each clinic. Each club is allowed to enter 4 juniors consisting of 2 boys and 2 girls or any combinations.
8. The final selection of participants for the clinics will be decided by the State Associations /Representatives and his Committee.
